Good luck, we'll cheer for you from the viewing area! ID, let Shuto warm up. Let's go, otherwise, we'll miss the start!

















Our No.1 character, Shuto, is a straight-A student, whom everyone he could get into trouble, but life might throw him a curveball as well.













































Slowy, who is the assistant of Dr. Pixie, knows a lot about HPV.
When he appears, he always brings us important information.






Sophie is the captain of the school's dance group,

so no surprise, It's a real privilege to join them.






















No need to be scared of the HPV vaccination!

In recent years, more than 200 million jabs have been given to people and research shows that side effects appeared only on rare occasions. Even when they did, they were very mild. These possible side effects could be itching or swelling at the location of the injection. Occasionally people have a temperature, a headache or feel some dizziness or sickness. Occasionally means that out of 1000 people only 1 would be affected. Under the age of 15 two vaccinations need to be taken within a year, over the age of 15 three vaccinations are recommended.










Jimmy, Shuto's best friend, takes good care of and vegetables in his diet, tries to avoid sugary foods and drinks and works out regularly.






























Meanwhile, Sophie's broken heart is ready to be healed. Is it possible that the disappointment will bring her and Shuto closer again?
































