As Head of Programmes at The Eve Appeal, the UK's national charity for gynaecological cancers, I oversee all research, communications, health information, awareness, and support activities. - **Exploring a competitive advocacy grant programme**, similar to the IGCS model, to support innovative grassroots projects.

There is still so much to build together. I am committed to strengthening ENGAGe's reach, impact, and community, and I would be honoured to continue contributing to this work.
